Murcia, 01/04/2019. Bankia and Fundación Cajamurcia have launched the '2019 Call for Social Action Aid', funded with 200,000 euros, to support social projects in the Region of Murcia.

The initiative is aimed at non-profit organisations that operate in the Region of Murcia and whose projects are aimed at training and guidance aimed at employment, rural development or, most especially, improving the quality of life of people with disabilities or other groups at risk of social exclusion.

The '2019 Call for Social Action Aid', which is part of the cooperation agreement signed by Bankia and Fundación Cajamurcia for Social Action in the Region of Murcia, will support projects with a minimum amount of 2,000 euros and a maximum amount of 12,000 euros.

Applicant entities can register through the [Fundación Cajamurcia](#) and [Bankia en acción](#) websites, that have been enabled for online submission of applications. The deadline for submission of projects ends on 25 April.

The entities and projects selected in the '2019 Call for Social Action' will be announced in June.
